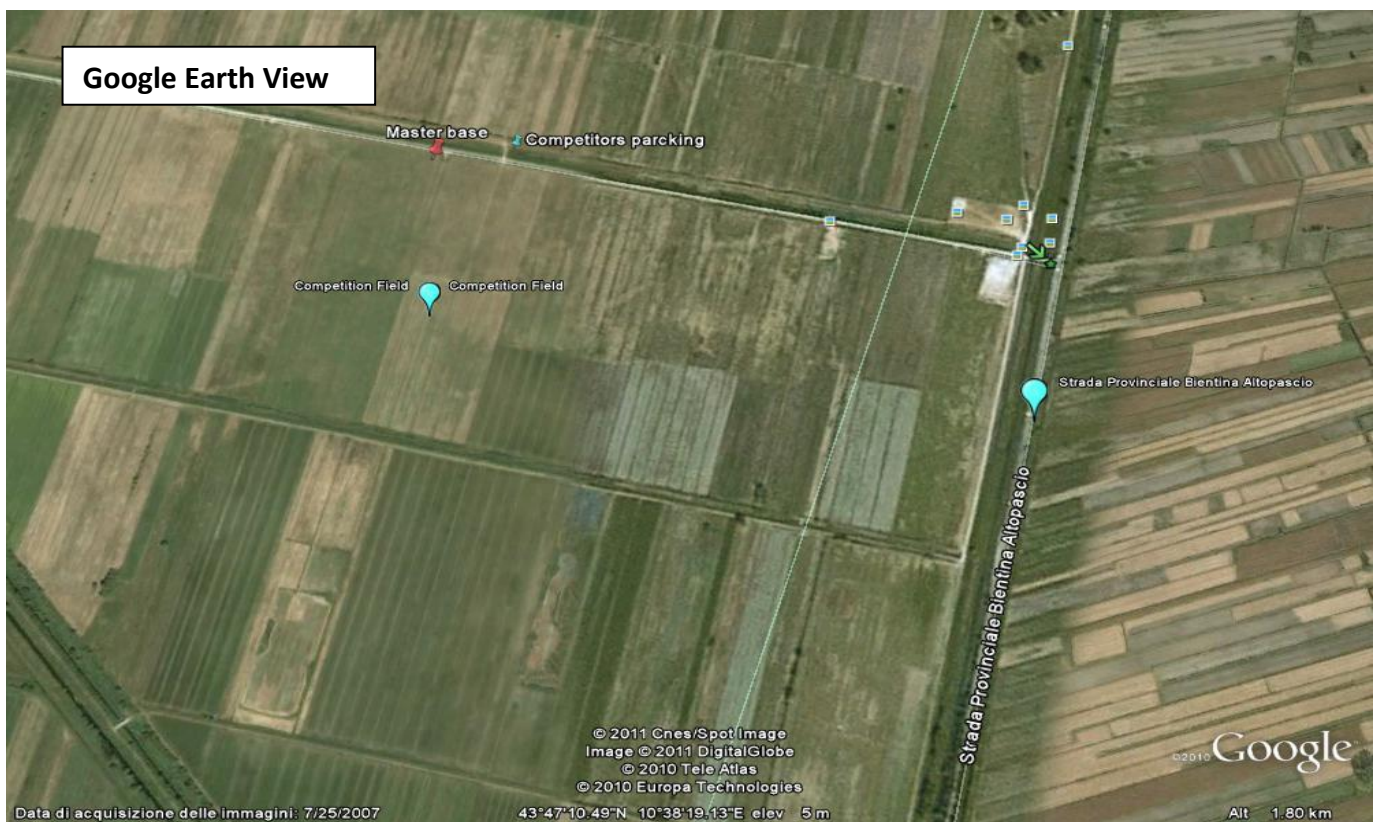
Place of contest

Padule di Bientina, Capannori, Lucca – Italy

Flying field located at about 15 km from Lucca (LU), 12 Km from Capannori and 6 Km from Altopascio, in a pleasant agricultural and historical area in the west side of Tuscany Region close to Lucca, Pistoia (35 Km), Firenze (76 Km), Pisa(38 Km) and Viareggio (23 Km).

Local Itineraries

The Airfield is located along the Bientinese Road at 12 Km from Capannori City and 6 Km from Altopascio going to Bientina. At critical crossings FAI signs will be posted.

Itineraries:

- A-B** Registration point : Gymnasium Hall, Maiorana high school, Via Guido Rossa – 55012 Capannori City: from highway Firenze – Pisa A11/E76, exit Capannori, take the left to down town following “FAI European Championships, Registration” signs, Via del Frizzone, Via Romana on the left, Via del Popolo, Via Guido Rossa, the place is at 3,5 Km from the highway Capannori exit.
(43°51'18,67" N; 10°34' 29,4" E),
- B-C** From Capannori City to Airfield: 12 Km and 15 min. trip by Via del Popolo, via del Casalino, Via Pieraccini, Via Bientinese, Padule di Bientina following signs “FAI European Championships” (43°47'26,6"N; 10°38'12,05" E)
- D-C** From highway Firenze-Pisa E76 to Airfield: exit at Altopascio then take on the right, following signs “FAI European Championships”, to Via delle Cerbaie then Via Callone, Viale Europa, S.Provinciale SP15 Bientina and then Via Bientinese SP3. About 6 Km and 8 min. driving from Altopascio.

The competition site can be easily reached arriving from different places through the A11/E76 highway:

Distances

- from Firenze (B): 70,9 Km by the highway E76,
- from Lucca (C): 12,4 Km,
- from Pisa (E): 37,6 Km,
- from Viareggio (D): 23,3 km

Closest Airports: Pisa - San Giusto and Firenze - Peretola.

Practice

Practice on the field may take place starting on Friday, the 3rd August, 2012 onward.

Entries

Application procedure will be published in the 2012 European Championships web-site, <http://www.ec2012italy.com>, and in the next Bulletin.

Team Managers will receive, after a preliminary registration, a password to register all participants sending individual data and photos.

A dedicated section will detail administrative data.

Entry Fees

Team Manager/Assistant TM:	150,00 Euro
Helpers/Supporters:	50,00 Euro
Banquet:	40,00 Euro - Free for Team Managers, Assistant TM and Competitors.

Payments

Sporting license

All participants, Competitors, Team Manager, Assistant Team managers are requested to hold a valid FAI License.

Competition rules

According to the valid FAI Sporting Code, as well as applicable amendments.

Insurance

Organiser will provide third party insurance cover to all participants.

Timekeepers

Each participating country may enter one timekeeper. The intention to enter a timekeeper will have to be registered on the entry form.

Accommodation and food shall be provided by the organiser.

These timekeepers shall act on all contest days, attend the briefing and bring their own equipments (binocular, tripod and stopwatch).



Accommodation

Two main hotels have been selected to accommodate the EChamp 2012 participants:

- **Capannori Country Club** (<http://www.booking.com/Hotel-Country-Club>), a three star plus hotel, 12 km distant from the airfield, with a capacity of 88 air conditioned twin rooms, 2 large swimming pools, Wi-fi, meeting rooms, secretarial service, large parking area etc..

Half Board applicable fares per night/per person are:

- Twin room, € 45
- Single room, € 60

The event management, the organisation staff, the help desk and other services will be available there.

The Team Managers and Timekeepers Meetings will take place there.

- **Le Cerbaie** (<http://www.lecerbaie.it>) a three stars plus hotel, 5 km distant from the airfield, with a capacity of 64 air conditioned twin rooms with free Wi-fi.

Half board applicable fares per night/per person are:

- Single room, € 60
- Twin room, € 45
- Triple room, € 40

Further to the above options a wide list of alternative accommodations in hotels, resorts, campings, farms and B&B, will be published with the next Bulletin.

Booking and payment of selected accommodations will be the responsibility of the event participants.

The event organisation will offer any necessary assistance.

Catering

Food stands for snacks and drinks will be available on the field.

Light meals will be served on the field in the competition days. Price per meal is € 10 to be paid together with entry fees.

Banquet

The banquet is offered by the organiser to team managers and competitors. Supporters and helpers may participate against payment of 40 Euro/person.

Language

Official language will be English and Italian.

Protest fee

A claim/protest may be submitted only by the Team Manager in accordance to the FAI Sporting Code 4 –Vol. F1 together with a sanction fee of 35 Euro to be refunded should the protest be upheld.

Anti-doping

All Participants are to abide by the WADA anti-doping rules. If a competitor has to take, for medical condition, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List must have a therapeutic use exemption from the FAI.

Medical assistance

During the Championships a medical equipe will be on the field for emergencies.

Visa to non EU citizens

Individual competitors and their National Team shall deal with their Authorities to get the necessary visas.

Organiser shall provide to all non EU citizens/teams an invitation letter which will be available together with the next bulletin.

Flags and National Anthems

All team managers are requested to provide their Country Flag and Anthem to organiser.
