VENUE AND CHAMPIONSHIP'S DATE

Belgrade, Serbia - Belgrade Fair - 8th to 13th August, 2012.

OFFICIAL LANGUAGES

The Official languages are English and Serbian.

WEATHER

During the summer prevails sunny and stable weather with minimal chances of rainfall. The average daily temperatures are 25 - 30 C.

RULES

Up to date and official regulations of FAI, Chapters 4a, Volumes ABR and F1, Edition Jan 1,2012.

SPORTS LICENSES

Every competitor and team manager is obliged to have valid FAI licenses for 2012.

PARTICIPATION

Competition is open to national teams of FAI members in both team and individual classification.

NATIONAL TEAMS

One national aeronautical club has the right to participate at the competition and it consists of:

- -Team manager (for seniors and juniors)
- -Team manager assistant
- -Maximum 3 senior competitors
- -Maximum 3 junior competitors
- -Senior World champion for 2010 (from the previous World Championship)
- -Junior World champion for 2010 (from the previous World Championship.

See "Age classification for the contest" of this Bulletin for his/her participation conditions.

- -One time keeper
- -Assistants, authorized press representatives

AGE CLASSIFICATION FOR THE CONTEST

According to the FAI Sporting Code, Section 4, Volume ABR, paragraph B.3.4 a.-competitor is considered to be a junior up to and including the calendar year in which he attains the age of 18. All other competitors are classed as Seniors.

ABR- B.3.4.b) When juniors and seniors fly together in the same site and at the same time, the junior competitors who are members of a national Senior team will appear in the individual senior classification, but must also be considered in the national Junior team and included in the Junior individual classification as far as the Junior national team is not complete. The names of the junior national team members must be declared before the beginning of the competition.

ABR B.3.4.d) Any Junior Word Champion who will be too old to defend his title at the next Word Championships for Juniors is entitled to fly in one Word Championship for Seniors, in the appropriate class, within the three calendar years following his becoming Junior Word Champion.

ENTRY FEES

300 euro - senior competitors 280 euro - junior competitors 200 euro - team managers 60 euro - helpers Note:

Fees should be paid no later than 30th April 2012. Later payments will be subjects to fines as follows: 30^{th} April – 31^{st} May, 10% 1^{st} June – 15^{th} July, 20% 15^{th} July – 31^{st} July, 35%

TIMEKEEPERS

Each national team has the right for one timekeeper. Organizer will provide for him local transportation, free accommodation and food, souvenirs and banquet. Judges must have 2 electronic stopwatches and must be able to speak the essential - technical English language.

BANQUET 40 euro per person for seniors and 35 euro per person for juniors.

AWARDS

The organizer shall provide FAI diplomas, FAI medals and organizer's trophies for three first three places in individual and

team classifications for seniors and juniors.

Also the following perpetual trophies shall be awarded:

- Individual Rushbrooke Trophy present holder I. Treger (SVK)
- Longest Flight Ernest Kopechy Memorial Trophy present holder I.
 Treger (SVK)
- Team Langley Cup present holder USA

ANTI-DOPING

If a competitor has to take any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited list for a medical condition, then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

DATA ON THE COMPETITION HALL

The height of the Hall 1 is 27,484 M. and it is the biggest and the highest Hall of the Belgrade Fair. 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011 was accomplished 4 records on a Belgrade Fair. Year 2010. Treger Ivan (SVK) was accomplished record (39 min. 27 sec.).
