Dear FAI Members,

The new FAI Sporting licence management software is now fully operational and all athletes of category 1 events must be entered into the system by NACs before competitions in 2014!

2014 category 1 events

It is now MANDATORY for all NACs to enter all their athletes competing in category 1 events into the FAI Sporting Licence database BEFORE the start of the competitions of this year.

There will be approximately 50 category 1 events in 2014, involving about 3500 athletes. The first category 1 event starts on 11 March 2014.

New FAI Sporting licence management

The new software for the management of FAI Sporting Licence is now ready to be used by all National Airsports Controls (NACs). Specially designed to respond to the NACs' needs, easy to get to grips with and use, it gives full control over all aspects of licence management, from data input to issue and validity check.

The new management software, together with the already existing upload tool, allows NACs to:

- Enter all athletes (Reminder : all athletes participating to Cat 1 events have to be entered)
 - o using the Sporting Licence upload tool (sportinglicences.fai.org/)
 - o manually with the new management system (sportinglicences2.fai.org/)
- Edit licences to change dates or other information of the licence
- Search for licences to check their validity
- Renew licences
- Create licences
- Print licences using a default template or by creating a new design
- Email licences to athletes
- Furthermore, new licences feature a QR code (2D barcode) making the checking of licences easier.
